**October 2010 Minutes**

Following are the minutes of a regular meeting of the officers and appointed frequency coordinators of SOUTHERN NEVADA REPEATER COUNCIL, INC., hereinafter SNRC, held at 8:00AM on October 29, 2010.

The following persons were present: Bill Smith, W7HMY, Nat Talpis, W7OQF both being officers of the corporation. In addition, coordinator, Blayne Ence, KG7SS, web site/database manager Steve Gebhard, WB9STH, and coordinator, Lee Dusbabek, N7LD (formerly K7KAJ) were present. Treasurer and coordinator Frank Kostelac, N7ZEV was unable to attend.

The Council reviewed two requests for two-meter repeaters in Nye County submitted by Dick Grady, AC7EL. Both repeaters will be owned/operated by the Southern Nye County ARES, Inc. One repeater will be located on Sawtooth Mtn., 6,005' MSL, approximately 5.5 miles NW of Beatty and will operate on 145.64MHz, w/50 watts output. The other repeater, which has been in operation for some time is located on Shader Peak, Johnnie, NV at 4,384' MSL, approximately 19 miles NNW of Pahrump. Although both repeaters will be operating in the segment of the band that has been designated for miscellaneous and experimental modes,

the Committee felt that due to their remote location, the repeaters should not pose any interference issues. Bill advised that he had checked the TASMA website and could find no conflicts with the two repeaters. Accordingly, the Committee approved the coordination requests. Bill will notify AC7EL.
